Please take note of the following guidelines when setting the exam papers:

1. Total marks must be out of 50 per paper.
2. Papers must be set at a level appropriate to the grade. Ensure that the exams are set within syllabus confines and that students are not tested on any work that was not covered in the text book.
3. The questions should be set in such a way that 50% (25 marks) should be easy allowing the weak learners to pass easily, 20% (10 marks) should be average to difficult and 20% (10 marks) more difficult for the above average learners. At least 5 marks should be challenging for the brilliant learners.
4. As far as possible, each paper must include at least four of the following categories:
  - a. Fill in the missing answers
  - b. True & False. If false, give the correct answer
  - c. Select answers from the next column or match column A with column B
  - d. Provide the relative dates [History Paper]
  - e. Answer the following questions
  - f. Definitions of terms
  - g. One or two short note questions (for the higher grades)
  - h. Translations of Arabic terms to English or English terms to Arabic (for the higher grades)
  - i. Check to ensure that the exams are set within syllabus confines and that students are not examined on any work that was not covered in the text books.
4. Each FIQH paper (from grades 3 to 7) MUST contain the following questions:
  - a. Faraaidh of wudhu
  - b. Faraaidh of ghusal
5. Papers need to be moderated by the Ta'limi Board. Thus, the set papers have to be handed in before 19 September 2008. This allows the Ta'limi Board sufficient time to type set, photocopy and pack the papers prior to the exams.
6. The final exams should contain at least 75 % of the questions from the second half of the years work.
7. Prepare answer sheets to enable quick marking.
