



An effort to mention some virtues of each dua was also made to serve as an encouragement for the pupils to recite these duas.

Parents need to play an important role of constantly encouraging and reminding their children to recite these duas at the appropriate time. Thus when the child is woken up in the morning, before he enters the toilet and after he leaves, before and after eating and at all other occasions, the parents should remind the child to recite the dua. In this way it will become a part of their lives and the purpose of teaching these duas will be achieved, insha Allah.

We make dua to Allah Ta'ala to accept this publication and make it a means of *hidaayat* for the *ummah* as well as *Sadaqah-e-Jaariyah* for us all. *Aameen*.

Ta'limi Board (KwaZulu Natal)



1. Kalimah Tayyibah

لَا إِلٰهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ مُحَمَّدٌ رَّسُولُ اللهِ

There is no God besides Allah Ta'ala. Hadhrat Muhammad مَتَأَيْتَهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَمٌ is the messenger of Allah Ta'ala.

VIRTUE:

Hadhrat Abu Darda مَعَالِمُهُ reports that Nabi مَعَالِمُهُ said, "Whoever reads this kalimah 100 times daily, his face will shine like a full moon on the Day of Qiyaamah."

(Fazail-e-A'amaal, Zikr pg.156 from Tabraani)

2. Kalimah Shahaadah

اَشْهَدُ اَنْ لَا اِلْهَ اللهُ وَاَشْهَدُ اَنَّ لَا اللهُ وَاشْهَدُ اَنَّ فَرَسُهُدُ اَنَّ فَحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ

I bear witness that there is no God besides Allah Ta'ala and I bear witness that Hadhrat Muhammad صَا اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَمَا اللهُ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَمَا اللهُ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَمَا اللهُ ال

Virtue

Nabi عَالَيْهُ said that on the day of Qiyaamah, in the presence of all mankind, Allah Ta'ala will call a person from my Ummah, who will have ninety-nine registers of bad deeds and each register will be as long as one can see. Then Allah Ta'ala will say there is one good deed to your credit. A small piece of paper with this Kalimah will be given to him. The ninety-nine registers will be placed on one side of the scale and this kalimah will be placed on the other side. The kalimah will outweigh the ninety-nine registers.

3. Kalimah Tamjid

سُبْحَانَ اللهِ وَالْحَمْدُ لِلهِ وَلَا اِلْهَ اللهَ اللهُ اللهُ وَلَا قُوَّةَ اللهُ وَاللهُ اَصْحَبُرُ وَلَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ اللهُ وَاللهُ اَصْحَبُرُ وَلَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةً اللهُ اللهِ الْعَلِيّ الْعَظِيْمِ اللهِ الْعَلِيّ الْعَظِيْمِ

Glory be to Allah Ta'ala and all praise be to Allah Ta'ala. There is no God besides Allah Ta'ala. And, Allah Ta'ala is the Greatest. There is no power and might except from Allah Ta'ala, The Most High, The Great.

Virtue

One who recites this kalimah 100 times in the morning and 100 times in the evening gets the reward of 100 Haj, giving 100 horses in the path of Allah, freeing 100 slaves,...and no one can match your sawaab for that day, unless he/she did the same.

(Tirmizi #3471)

4. Kalimah Tawheed

لَا اِلٰهَ اِللهَ وَحُدَهُ لَا شَرِيْكَ لَهُ لَهُ اللهُ اللهُ وَحُدَهُ لَا شَرِيْكَ لَهُ لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ يُحْيِيْ وَيُمِيْتُ بِيدِهِ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ يُحْيِيْ وَيُمِيْتُ بِيدِهِ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيْرُ الْحَيْرُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيْرُ

There is no God besides Allah Ta'ala. He is One. He has no partner. For Him is the kingdom and for Him is all praise. He gives life and causes death. In His hand is all good. And He has power over everything.

Virtue

One who recites this kalimah 10 times after Maghrib Salaah, will be greatly rewarded and Allah Ta'ala will send special guardian angels to protect him from shaytaan right until the morning.

(Tirmizi 3474 and 3534)

5. Kalimah Rad-de Kufr

اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنِّى اَعُوْدُ بِكَ مِنْ اَنْ اُشْرِكَ بِكَ شَيْعًا وَّانَا اَعْلَمُ بِهٖ وَاسْتَغْفِرُكَ لِمَا لَا شَيْعًا وَّانَا اَعْلَمُ بِهٖ وَاسْتَغْفِرُكَ لِمَا لَا اَعْلَمُ بِهٖ وَاسْتَغْفِرُكَ لِمَا لَا اَعْلَمُ بِهٖ تُبْتُ عَنْهُ وَتَبَرَّاتُ مِنَ الْكُفُرِ وَالشَّرُكِ وَالْمَعَاضِى كُلِّهَا اَسْلَمْتُ وَامَنْتُ وَامْنْتُ وَالشَّهُ وَالشَّهُ وَالشَّهُ وَاللَّهُ مُحَمَّدٌ رَسُولُ اللهِ وَاقُولُ لَا اِللهَ إِلَّا الله مُحَمَّدٌ رَسُولُ اللهِ

GRADE 1

O Allah Ta'ala! I seek protection in You from that I should join any partner with You knowingly. I seek Your forgiveness from that which I do not know. I repent from ignorance. I free myself from disbelief and from joining partners with You, and I free myself from all sins. I submit to Your will. I believe and I declare: There is no God besides Allah Ta'ala Hadhrat Muhammad

Virtue

Nabi مَا الله مَا الله مَا مَا الله مَ

(Ibnus Sunni pg. 250)

6. Imaani-Mujmal

I believe in Allah Ta'ala as He is by His names and His qualities and I accept all His orders.

Virtue

Nabi مَا الله explained that at times Shaytaan tries to confuse a person regarding his belief in Allah Ta'ala, and he (Shaytaan) should just be ignored. (Mishkaat pg.18) This kalimah is very effective in repelling doubts and confusion from Shaytaan.

7. Imaani-Mufassal

أَمَنْتُ بِاللهِ وَمَلْيِكَتِهِ وَكُتُبِهِ وَرُسُلِهِ وَالْيَوْمِ الْأَخِرِ وَالْقَدْرِ خَيْرِهٖ وَشَرِّهٖ مِنَ اللهِ تَعَالَى وَالْبَعْثِ بَعْدَ الْمَوْتِ

I believe in Allah Ta'ala, His Angels, His Books, His Messengers, the Last Day, and in Taqdeer, that all good and bad is from Allah Ta'ala, and I believe in the life after death.

Note:

Once Nabi صَّالَتُهُ عَلَيْهُ وَسَلَّمُ was asked what is Imaan? Nabi صَّالَتُهُ عَلَيْهُ وَسَلَّمُ explained the important aspects which one has to believe in, in order to be a Believer.

(Bukhaari V.1 Pg. 12)

These are all mentioned in Imaan-e-Mufassal.

Note:

Reading of all seven kalimahs every night is a type of renewal of our Imaan in our beliefs, which we need to do especially after being exposed to many un Islamic beliefs in schools, newspapers, etc. Caution demands that a person renews his Imaan everyday.

8. When greeting a Muslim, say

اَلسَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ وَ رَحْمَةُ اللهِ وَ بَرَكًا تُهُ

May the Peace, Mercy and blessings of Allah Ta'ala be upon you.

9. In reply to a greeting, say


May the Peace, Mercy and blessings of Allah Ta'ala be upon you.

10. When welcoming someone say

(May you enter and) be as one of us, be at ease and comfortable, and welcome (to you).

(Tirmizi, Ibnu Majah)

11. Before eating



In the name of Allah Ta'ala and upon the blessings of Allah Ta'ala.

(Al-Hisnul Haseen Pg. 141)

Virtue

One who reads this dua will receive blessing in one's meals.

12. When forgetting to recite the dua before eating

In the name of Allah Ta'ala in the beginning and the end.

(Abu Dawood, Vol. 2, Pg. 173)

Virtue

Once Rasulullah مِنْمِ اللهُ saw a man who started his meal without saying مِنْمِ اللهُ اللهُ اللهُ اللهُ اللهُ اللهُ اللهُ اللهُ اللهُ أَوْلَهُ وَ الْحِرَهُ When he was about to finish, he remembered and recited مِنْمِ اللهُ وَلَهُ وَ الْحِرَهُ Rasulullah مَنْ said: From the begining of the meal, Shaytaan was eating with him, but when he remembered and read this dua, Shaytaan couldn't join any more, instead whatever Shaytaan ate, he had to vomit it out.

13. After eating

ٱلْحَمْدُ لِلهِ الَّذِي ٱطْعَمَنَا وَسَقَانَا وَجَعَلَنَا

مِنَ الْمُسْلِمِيْنَ

All praise be to Allah Ta'ala who gave us food and drink and made us Muslims.

(Al-Hisnul Haseen Pg. 144)

Virtue

Allah Ta'ala becomes pleased when His slave praises Him after meals.

Sunnats of eating

- 1. Wash both your hands before eating
- 2. Recite 'Bismillah wa'la barakatillah' aloud.
- 3. Eat with the right hand.
- 4. Do not lean and eat.
- 5. Do not find fault with the food.
- 6. Whilst eating one should not remain completely silent.
- 7. Eat with three fingers as far as possible.
- 8. First remove the food from the dastarkhaan then get up.
- 9. After meals wash both your hands.

14. Before sleeping

اَللَّهُمَّ بِاسْمِكَ اَمُوْتُ وَاحْيى

O Allah Ta'ala, with Your name do I die and live.

(Tirmizi, Vol. 2, Pg. 178)

15. When awakening

اَلْحَمْدُ لِللهِ الَّذِي اَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا اَمَاتَنَا وَلَيْهُ النَّشُورُ وَإِلَيْهِ النُّشُورُ

All praise is due to Allah Ta'ala who has given us life after death and to Him is our return after death.

(Bukhaari Vol. 2 Pg. 934)

Sunnats of sleeping

- 1. To sleep in the state of wudhu.
- 2. Dust the bed thrice before retiring to bed.
- 3. To apply surmah in both the eyes.
- 4. To brush the teeth with a miswaak.
- 5. To sleep on the right hand side.
- 6. To sleep with the right palm under the right cheek
- 7. To keep the knees slightly bent when sleeping.
- 8. To refrain from sleeping on one's stomach.
- 9. To sleep on a bed or to sleep on the floor are both sunnah.
- 10. To face the Qiblah.
- 11. To recite Aayatul Kursi before sleeping.
- 12. To recite Tasbeeh-e-Faathimi before sleeping.

16. Before entering the toilet

اَللَّهُمَّ اِنِّي اَعُوْذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْخُبُثِ وَالْخَبَايِثِ

O Allah Ta'ala, I seek Your protection from the male and female Devil.

(Tirmizi, Vol. 1, Pg. 3)

17. After leaving the toilet

غُفْرَانَكَ ٱلْحَمْدُ لِلهِ الَّذِي اَذُهَبَ عَنِي الْآذٰى وَعَافَانِيۡ الْآذٰى وَعَافَانِيۡ

O Allah! I seek Your forgiveness. All praise be to Allah Ta'ala who removed from me discomfort and gave me relief.

(Ibnu Majah, Pg.26)

Sunnats of the toilet

- 1. Enter the toilet with your head covered.
- 2. Enter the toilet with shoes.
- 3. Enter with the left foot.
- 4. Sit and urinate. One should never urinate whilst standing.
- 5. Leave the toilet with the right foot.
- 6. Recite the dua after coming out of the toilet.
- 7. Do not face or show one's back towards the Qiblah.
- 8. Be very careful of the splashes of urine. (Being unmindful in this regard causes one to be punished in the grave.)
- 9. After relieving oneself, to clean oneself with water.

18. When thanking someone

جَزَاكَ اللهُ خَيْرًا

May Allah Ta'ala reward you well.



19. when intending to do something

إِنْ شَاءَ اللهُ

If Allah Ta'ala wills.

20. When Sneezing



All praise be to Allah Ta'ala.

The listener's reply

May Allah Ta'ala have mercy on you.

The sneezer's response

May Allah Ta'ala guide you and rectify your condition.

(Abu Dawood, Vol. 2, Pg. 338)

21. For increase in knowledge

رَبِّ زِدْنِيْ عِلْمًا

O My Rabb, Increase me in knowledge.

(Sura Taaha, S.20/V.114)

Virtue

By reciting this Dua one's memory will strengthen Insha Allah.

22. Dua for parents

رَبِّ ارْحَمُهُمَا كُمَا رَبَّيَانِيْ صَغِيْرًا

O Allah Ta'ala! Have mercy upon them as they had mercy upon me when I was small.

(Surah. 17, V. 24)

Note:


- 1. Don't cause harm to your parents.
- 2. Don't speak rudely to them.
- 3. Don't back chat them.
- 4. Respect your grandparents like how you will respect your parents.
- 5. Make dua for them regularly.
- 6. Meet their friends and relatives in a good and friendly way.
- 7. If they have passed away, make dua for them and send e-saale thawab for them every day.

23. Durood Shareef

O Allah, grant Your special mercy on our Master Muhammad مَا اَللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ and on the family of our Master Muhammad مَا اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ and bless our Master Muhammad مَا اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ and peace be on our Master Muhammad مَا اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ اللهُ اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ .

Virtue:

- 1. One who recites Durood once will receive ten rewards, ten sins will be forgiven and his rank will be raised ten times in the hereafter.
- 2. Nabi صَاَلَتُهُ عَلَيْهِ has said: "The closest person to me on the day of Qiyaamah is he who reads the most durood upon me."



24. Takbeer

أَللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ

Allah Ta'ala is the greatest.

25. Sanaa

سُبْحَانَكَ اللَّهُمَّ وَبِحَمْدِكَ وَتَبَارَكَ اسْمُكَ وَتَعَالَى جَدُّكَ وَلَا إِلٰهَ غَيْرُكَ

Glory be to You O Allah Ta'ala Praise be to You, blessed is Your name, very lofty is Your greatness, and there is no Deity besides You.

(Tirmizi, Vol. 1, Pg. 33)

26. Ta'awwuz

اَعُوْذُ بِاللهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيْمِ

I seek protection in Allah Ta'ala from shaytaan, the rejected.

27. Tasmiyah

In the name of Allah Ta'ala, the Most Kind, the Most Merciful.

28. Tasbeeh in Ruku

Glory be to My Rabb, the Great.

(Tirmizi, Vol. 1, Pg. 35)

29. Tasmee'

Allah Ta'ala hears the one who praises Him.

30. Dua in Qaumah (1)

O Allah Ta'ala! Our Sustainer! Unto You belongs all praise.

(Ibnu Majah, Pg. 62)

31. Dua in Qaumah (2)

رَبَّنَا وَلَكَ الْحَمْدُ حَمْدًا كَثِيْرًا طَيِّبًا مُّبَارِكًا فِيْهِ

O Allah Ta'ala, praise be to You many pure blessed praises.

(Bukhaari Vol.1 Pg.110)

Once, Nabi مَثَوَاتُهُ عَالِيهُ was performing Salaah with the Sahaabah when one Sahaabi read these words after standing up from ruku. When Rasulullah مَثَالِتُهُ عَلَيْهُ وَسَالَةُ completed the salaah, he asked who had read these words. One Sahaabi replied that he had recited it. Nabi مَثَالِتُهُ عَلَيْهُ وَسِّلَةً then said, "I saw 30 angels rushing to the words to see who would be the first to record them."

Etiquettes of Dua

- 1. Every Muslim must make dua and beg Allah Ta'ala for his needs.
- 2. Be in the state of wudhu when making dua.
- 3. Sit in tashah-hud position.
- 4. Raise both hands up to the chest.
- 5. Praise Allah Ta'ala and recite Durood Shareef before making dua.
- 6. First ask for forgiveness.
- 7. Beg Allah Ta'ala from the bottom of your heart.
- 8. Cry if you can otherwise make like you crying.
- 9. Recite Durood Shareef again at the end of your dua.
- 10. End by saying Aameen and wipe your hands over your face.
