

# Hijrat (migration) to Madinah

1. The Kuffar of Makkah became very angry when they heard about the people of Madinah accepting Islam. They began making new plans to harm the Muslims.

4. Abu Jahl said, “From each tribe one person will be chosen to take part in the killing so that the family of Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ Banu Hashim cannot take revenge”.

2. Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ permitted the Sahabah رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُمْ to migrate secretly to Madinah until only Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ Abu Bakr, Ali رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ and few weak \ old Sahabah رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُمْ were left in Makkah.

5. Allah informed Nabi(S.A.W) of their plans and commanded him to make Hijrat to Madinah that same night.

6. The same night, Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ made Ali رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ sleep on his bed and told him to return all the goods of those people who have kept their trust by him the next day. The kuffar were waiting outside Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ house to kill him. Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ came out of his house reciting Surah Yaseen, Allah blinded them and Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ went to Abu Bakr رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ house and they both left Makkah and hid in the cave of Saur.

3. Abu Bakr رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ was waiting for Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ to make hijrat. He had two camels ready for this journey. The Kuffar gathered at Darun – Nadwa to decide how to stop Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ. Finally Abu Jahl said, “Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ must be killed.
