

Battle of Mu'ta (8 A.H)

Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ sent Haaris bin Umair رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ to invite the Christian chief called Shurahbeel who was a governor of Busra in Syria. Shurahbeel killed Haaris رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ.

Nabi صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ sent an army of 3000 to Punish this Chief.

Allah Ta'ala help was with the Muslims, He put such fear in the Romans heart that ran away and the Muslims gain victory.

Shurahbeel asked the Roman and Christian tribes for help. The Muslims had to face an army of 150 000 (3 muslims against 150 Kuffaar).

Three leaders of the muslim army were made maytred:

Zaid bin Haaris رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ Ja'far رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ

Abdullah bin Rawaaha رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ.

After that the muslims chose Khalid bin Waleed. He made the Muslims gain Victory. He got the title SAIFULLAH (The Sword of Allah)
