How to go about Doing Revision

Written Subjects

FIQH AQAAID & HISTORY

- Summarise lessons into worksheets
- Set up Mock Exams
- Work on the weak areas
- Draw up charts on the more important lessons

Oral Subjects

HADEETH

- Put up charts
- Refer to the charts
- Daily revise the Ahaadeeth of one grade
- Test each child individually

SURAHS AND DUAAS

- Ascertain the number of surahs and Duaas
- Complete revision of all Surahs and Duaas at least 3 times
- Test each student Individually
- Pay more attention to the weaker learners
- Fill in the progress cards

QUR-AAN

1. Grade R and One / Two:

- Syllabus to be completed as soon as possible
- Revision of the entire kitaab must be done at least three times (Aprox 3 pages a day)

2. Grade Two / Three:

- The same can be done for the first and second Para
- Get the class to sit in a group
- Each pupil should get a turn to read some part of the Dhor

3. Grade Three / Four to Grade Seven:

- Although it may be difficult in grade 6 and 7 to do the entire dhor of all the work covered, A revision program should nevertheless be drawn out on how much of revision must be done daily.
- At least revision of the work done for this year should be done.
