Rasulullah (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) said that one who recites Aayatul Kursi before sleeping will be protected by an angel appointed by Allah Ta'ala, and no shaytaan will come close to him till the morning.

He began pleading with me saying that he has a family and he is very much in need so I felt pity for him and let him go.

The next morning Rasulullah (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) asked me what had happened and I explained why I let the intruder go. He told me that he will come again the following day. I waited for him the next day and as predicted by Rasulullah (sallallahu alayhi wasallam), he appeared once again looking for food.

I caught him and threatened to take him once again to Rasulullah (sallallahu alayhi wasallam).
