

# DUA WHEN WALKING TO THE MASJID

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ بِحَقِّ السَّائِلِينَ عَلَيْكَ وَبِحَقِّ مَمْشَايَ هَذَا فَإِنِّي  
لَمْ أَخْرُجْ أَشْرًا وَلَا بَطْرًا وَلَا رِيَاءً وَلَا سُمْعَةً. خَرَجْتُ إِتْقَاءَ سَخِطِكَ  
وَابْتِغَاءَ مَرْضَاتِكَ أَسْأَلُكَ أَنْ تُنْقِذَنِي مِنَ النَّارِ وَأَنْ تَغْفِرَ لِي ذُنُوبِي  
إِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

*O Allah! I beg of You through the blessings of those who beg of You and through this walking of mine. I have not come out with arrogance nor with pride nor with show nor fame. Rather I came out fearing Your displeasure and seeking Your pleasure. I beg of You, O Allah, that You save me from the fire (of Jahannam) and that You forgive my sins for verily none but You forgives sins.*

It is mentioned in a Hadith that whomsoever recites this dua when walking towards the Masjid, Allah Ta'ala appoints 70 000 Malaaikeh to seek forgiveness on his behalf and Allah Ta'ala places His special *tawajjuh* (focus) on him until he completes his salaah.
