A Christian chief called Shurhabeel from Syria killed one of the messengers of Nabi مَرَاللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ.

He also wanted to attack the Muslims in Madinah.

Nabi صَالَاتُهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالَم sent an army of 3000 muslims to punish this chief.

Shurhabeel asked the Roman and Christian tribes for help. The Muslims had to face an army of 100 000.
