

Battle of Uhud (3rd A.H)

The defeat at Badr made the Kuffar want to take revenge. **3000** soldiers set out from Makaah back to Madinah. The Muslim army were **1000** soldiers.

Khaleed bin Waleed who was not a Muslim at that time attacked the Muslims from behind.

300 hypocrites (those who pretended to be Muslims) led by **Abdullah bin Ubay** left the Muslims after seeing the large Kuffar Army, now the Muslim army were only **700**. The 2 armies met at **Mount Uhud, 5KM** from Madinah.

Muslims were surprised and fought back bravely. The **Uncle of Nabi** صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ **Hamza** رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ was killed.

A **group of archers** were told to guard a mountain pass. Muslims fought bravely and Kuffar began running away. Archers taught the battle was over and left their guarding place.

70 Muslims lost their lives.
