Battle of Uhud (3rd A.H)

The defeat at Badr made the Kuffar want to take revenge. 3000 soldiers set out from Makaah back to Madinah. The Muslim army were 1000 soldiers.

Khaleed bin Waleed who was not a Muslim at that time attacked the Muslims from behind.

300 hypocrites (those who pretended to be muslims) led by Abdullah bin Ubay left the Muslims after seeing the large Kuffar Army, now the Muslim army were only 700. The 2 armies met at Mount Uhud, 5KM from Madinah.

Muslims were surprised and fought back bravely. The Uncle of Nabi مَالِلُكُ عَلَيْدُ وَسَلَمْ was killed.
