## Hijra/Migration to Habsha

**First Migration** allowed the صَرَّالَلَهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ allowed the Sahabah is to migrate to Habsha in the 5<sup>th</sup> Year after Nubuwat, so they may worship Allah in peace. On 5<sup>th</sup> Rajab, 11 men and 5 women **left for** Habsha. The Kuffar sent Amr bin A'as & Abdullah bin Umayyah to Habsha to bring back the Muslims.

Amr bin A'as & Abdullah bin Umayyah tried to bribe the King with a lot of gifts, so that the king send the Muslims back. However the King wanted to hear the رضَوَاللَّهُ Muslims side of their story first: Jaffar رضَوَاللَّهُ عَنْهُ delivered an inspiring speech, he said we all use to be misguided and do evil actions, however Islam came and reformed us. Thereafter he recited a few verses from Surah Maryam explaining the beliefs of Isa عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامُ Maryam المُعَادِي السَّلَامُ Maryam عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامُ المُعَادِ السَّلَامُ المُعَادِ السَ refused to hand over the Muslims to the Kuffar, This King name was known as Najashi.

## **Second Migration**

The Muslims were living in peace in Habsha, suddenly news came to them that everyone in Makkah accepted Islam, so they returned but it was a false rumor. Nabi permitted them to leave for Habsha in the 7th year after Nubuwat. A group of صرَّالله عَلَيْه وَسَلَّم 83 men and 18 women migrated to Habsha. The Yemeni Muslims from the tribe of Abu Moosa Ash'ari رَضِوَاللَّهُ عَنْهُ also joined them.
