Nabi (S.A.W) Last Words

A'isha (R.A) mentioned that during Nabi (S.A.W) illness, Sometime Nabi (S.A.W) would say, "May the curse of Allah be upon the Christians and Jews. They changed the graves of their Prophets into a place of worship. (instead of asking Allah, they began asking the prophets). Nabi (S.A.W) is telling us muslims that we must not do like them. Just before Nabi (S.A.W) passed away, He was saying, O Allah! Join me to The One Who is Most Kind and Most High (referring to Allah himself). Thereafter Nabi (S.A.W) used to say, "Guard Your Salaah, Guard your Salaah. After Nabi (S.A.W) passed away, Sahabah could not contain themselves, Umar (R.A) began denying that Nabi (S.A.W) passed away and other sahabah were in confusion.

Abu Bakr (R.A) delivered a lecture encouraging the Sahabah to make sabr (to have patience): He said, "Whoever worship Muhammad (S.A.W)m then know well that Muhhammad (S.A.W) has passed away. And Whoever worship Allah, then know well that Allah is HAYYUN QAYYOOM (Ever Living). After the Sahabah heard this, they came back to their senses. Sahabah reliaze that the most important thing now is to appoint the khalifah. Therefore Nabi (S.A.W) was only buried on Wednesday night (Thursday morning, at sehri time). Nabi (S.A.W) was buried in room of A'isha (R.A), the same place where he passed away.

The Mubaarak Features of Nabi (S.A.W):

- 1. Nabi (S.A.W) was neither Tall or Short. He was Moderate height.
- 2. His Mubarak head was fairly large and his beard was thick. He had 20 to 25 white strand of hair.
- 3. Nabi (S.A.W) Mubarak face was very bright and handsome.
- 4. His perspiration had an amazing fragrance. When it's dripped from his Mubarak face, it would be as if they were pearls.
- 5. The skin of Nabi (S.A.W) was softer than silk and the smell from his Mubarak body was more fragrant than musk and amber.
- 6. The hair of Nbi (S.A.W) used to sometime reach his shoulder and other times till his earlobes.
- 7. Nabi (S.A.W) eyes used to appear as if surmah has just been applied naturally. but He still put surmah to his eyes often. His eyes were dark black and slightly reddish. They were extremely beautiful and wide.
- 8. A thin line of hair was running from the chest to the navel.
- 9. The walk of Nabi (S.A.W) was such that he placed his foot firmly on the ground, it would seem as if he is descending from a high place.
- 10. The seal of prophethood was between the 2 shoulder blades but it was more towards the right side. This seal had a special sign which was mentioned in the previous books.
