

Clothing, Character & Miracles of Nabi ﷺ

Clothing

Topee: Was flat and would sit firmly on his Mubarak head.

A'maamah (Turban): Nabi ﷺ wear a topee under his turban. The tali of the turban would sometimes be between the 2 shoulder blades or on the right or left shoulder.

Kurta: Nabi ﷺ loved the kurta, the collar was situated near the chest.

Lungi (Lower Garment): His lungi used to reach upto his shins.

Trousers: Nabi ﷺ bought a trouser and liked it but he never had an opportunity of wearing it.

Khuf (Leather Socks): He would wear leather socks and would make masah of it at times of wudhu.

Pillow: It was made of leather and the inside of the pillow was pieces of bark from the date palm. Nabi ﷺ used to sleep on a straw mat.

Footwear: His shoe was similar to a sandal, the bottom had a leather layer and 2 straps were attached to the sandal so that the Mubarak toes would fit in.

Mu'jizaat (Miracles)

Allah used to allow the Ambiyaa(Prophets) to do miracles as a sign of them being prophets and to show their enemies that they cannot overpower them. The other prophets miracles were restricted to their lifetime, however some miracles of Nabi ﷺ will remain till the day of Qiyamat like the Quraan Shareef. Nabi ﷺ performed many other miracles like splitting of the moon, the stones and trees making salaam to him etc etc etc..

Character & Habits

1. Nabi ﷺ was always concerned of the hereafter.
2. Nabi ﷺ had a soft nature and gentle in his speech.
3. Nabi ﷺ never considered any gift to be insignificant.
4. He always spoke clearly but not unnecessarily.
5. He never became angry for personal reasons except when the command of Allah was broken, he would express his anger and turn his Mubarak face away.
6. He stayed away from evil speech, shamelessness and immorality.
7. He would carry out the daily chores at home and fulfill all his needs himself.
8. He was always fulfilling the needs of others.
9. He loved good smells and disliked bad smells.
He used to greet everyone with a smiling face.
10. There used to be starvation in the house of Nabi ﷺ, sometimes for 2 months, the fire was never lit in his house.
