

VIRTUES OF AWWAABEEN SALAAH

عَنْ أَبِي هُرَيْرَةَ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ مَنْ صَلَّى بَعْدَ الْمَغْرِبِ سِتَّ رَكَعَاتٍ لَمْ يَتَكَلَّمْ فِيمَا بَيْنَهُنَّ بِسُوءٍ عَدَلْنَ بِعِبَادَةِ ثِنْتَيْ عَشْرَةَ سَنَةً

Sayyiduna Abu Hurayrah (radiyallahu anhu) narrates that Rasulullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ said: “Whoever offers six rakaats after Maghrib Salaah, without evil talk in between, a reward equivalent to twelve years of ibaadat is given to him” [At-Targheeb #850]

قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ مَنْ صَلَّى بَعْدَ الْمَغْرِبِ سِتَّ رَكَعَاتٍ غُفِرَتْ لَهُ ذُنُوبُهُ وَإِنْ كَانَتْ مِثْلَ زَبَدِ الْبَحْرِ

Rasulullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ said, “Whoever performs six rak’aats after Maghrib Salaah, will have all his sins forgiven, even if it equals the foam of the ocean.” [At-Targheeb #852]

عَنْ سَالِمِ بْنِ عَبْدِ اللَّهِ عَنْ أَبِيهِ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ سَمِعْتُ النَّبِيَّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ يَقُولُ مَنْ صَلَّى سِتَّ رَكَعَاتٍ بَعْدَ الْمَغْرِبِ قَبْلَ أَنْ يَتَكَلَّمَ غُفِرَ لَهُ بِهَا ذُنُوبُ خَمْسِينَ سَنَةً

Rasulullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ has said, “Whoever offers six rak’aats after Maghrib before speaking to anyone, his sins of fifty years will be forgiven.” (Mukhtasar Qiyaamul Layl, pg.73)

Rasulullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ said, “The person who performs ten rakaats between Maghrib and Esha, a palace will be built for him in Jannah.” Hearing this, Hadhrat Umar (radhiyallahu anhu) exclaimed, “In that case, we will acquire abundant palaces, O Rasul of Allah” Rasulullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ replied, “Allah Ta’ala’s treasures are more and greater than anything one can imagine (i.e. Allah Ta’ala’s treasures will never deplete and He will continue to bless you)” [Kitaabuz Zuhd war Raqaaiq Page 446]

عَنْ ابْنِ عُمَرَ قَالَ مَنْ آدَمَنَ عَلَى أَرْبَعِ رَكَعَاتٍ بَعْدَ الْمَغْرِبِ كَانَ كَالْمُعَقَّبِ عَزْوَةً بَعْدَ عَزْوَةٍ

Hadhrat Abdullah bin Umar (radhiyallahu anhuma) mentioned, “The one who is punctual on performing four rakaats of salaah after Maghrib is like the one who remains perpetually engaged in jihaad, waging one battle after the next.” [Kitabuz Zuhd war Raqaaiq Page 446]
