## VIRTUES OF SLEEPING WITH WUDHU

• قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ

Rasulullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ has said, “A person who goes to sleep in the state of wudhu has an angel that spends the night with him. Every time he turns over, the angel says, ‘O Allah! Forgive Your slave, for he went to bed with wudhu.’” [Tabraani

#5087]

• قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ:

Abu Darda (radiyallahu anhu) has said, “When a person sleeps, his soul rises to the Arsh of Allah. If he slept in wudhu, the soul is permitted to make sajdah (the entire night). If he slept in the state of impurity, permission is refused.” [Fathul Baari #1149]

• قَالَ رَسُولُ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ:

Rasulullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ has said, “Whoever retires to bed in the state of wudhu, and falls off to sleep whilst making zikr of Allah, his bed will be regarded as a masjid and he will receive the reward of being in salaah and zikr until he awakens.”
